Napa Valley – best known for Cabernet Sauvignon – also produces Sauvignon Blanc. We recommend:

### St. Supéry Napa Valley Sauvignon Blanc

This winery – owned by France's Robert Skalli family – was planted in 1982 to Bordeaux grape varieties. This Sauvignon Blanc has a New Zealand-like quality; slight boxwood pungency, lemon verbena, lime and pomelo with grapefruit on the long crisp, mouth-filling finish.
