## What is Napa Green Certified Land?

- Enhances the watershed and restores habitat with sustainable agriculture practices
- Open to all Napa Valley grape growers
  - 45,000 acres are enrolled in the program, with over 19,000 acres certified (June 2011)

## Who conducts the environmental certification?

- National Marine Fisheries Service
- Department of Fish and Game
- Regional Water Quality Control Board

# DOLLARHIDE ESTATE

- Purchased and developed in 1982
- Pioneering spirit saw the potential of this valley within Napa Valley
- 1500 acres
  - 1/3 in vines
  - 2/3 natural wildlife corridor



# DOLLARHIDE ESTATE

## Diversity

- Rolling hillside vineyards at elevations from 600 - 1100 ft above sea level
- 12 different soil series (types) and 16 different variations

## Biodiversity

- Napa Green certified
- Vast array of wildlife in mini flora and fauna ecosystems

## Grapes Grown

- Dollarhide Sauvignon Blanc and Cabernet Sauvignon
- Origin of all St. Supéry's white wine, including Virtú
- Bordeaux varieties

  - Red Bordeaux varietals for Elu
