
**Richard Seiferheld**

# 2022 Holiday Dinner Recipes

**A. Endive, Watercress, and Fennel Salad with Goat Cheese and Pomegranate Seeds**  
 4 ea. endive, bottoms cut off and leaves picked  
 1 bunch watercress, leaves picked  
 2 Tbsp. whole parsley leaves  
 1 small bulb fennel, cored and very thinly sliced  
 2 Tbsp. pomegranate seeds  
 2 oz. crumbled goat cheese  
 1 Tbsp. pomegranate molasses  
 1 Tbsp. white wine vinegar  
 1 tsp. minced shallot  
 ½ tsp. minced thyme  
 Salt  
 Pepper  
 ¼ C olive oil



**B. Roasted Rainbow Carrots with Mustard Green-Walnut Pistou**  
 2 bunches rainbow baby carrots, peeled  
 ½ tsp. smoked paprika  
 ½ tsp. cumin  
 ½ tsp. garlic powder  
 Salt  
 Pepper  
 ⅓ C + 1 Tbsp. olive oil, divided  
 1 clove garlic  
 1 C mustard greens, stalk removed and leaves coarsely chopped  
 ¼ C parsley, coarsely chopped  
 ½ C chopped, toasted walnuts, divided in half  
 1 tsp. lemon zest  
 2 Tbsp. lemon juice



**C. Green Beans with Orange Zest, Toasted Coriander, and Crème Fraiche**  
 1 lb. green beans  
 Salt  
 Pepper  
 1 Tbsp. butter  
 1 tsp. orange zest  
 ¼ tsp. ground coriander  
 ½ C crème fraiche  
 1 Tbsp. minced parsley



**D. Potatoes Anna**  
 6 medium Yukon Gold potatoes, peeled and thinly sliced  
 6 Tbsp. butter, melted  
 2 Tbsp. olive oil  
 Salt  
 Pepper  
 1 tsp. minced thyme



**E. Rosemary-crust Standing Beef Rib Roast with Cranberry-Horseradish Relish**  
 ½ C Dijon mustard  
 2 Tbsp. minced garlic  
 ¼ C chopped rosemary  
 ¼ C olive oil  
 Salt  
 Coarse-ground black pepper  
 12 lb. bone-in rib roast



**F. Dark Chocolate-Black pepper Shortbread**  
 1 C unsalted butter, softened  
 1 C powdered sugar  
 1 tsp. vanilla  
 1 ¾ C flour  
 ¼ C cornstarch  
 ½ C unsweetened dark chocolate cocoa powder  
 ⅛ tsp. ground black pepper  
 ½ tsp. salt  
 1 recipe royal icing, if desired, or other decorative toppings



### November 15 | The deLeuze Family Endowed Professorship with Brett deLeuze, President of ZD Wines




