St. Supéry Estate Vineyards and Winery is a 100% Estate winery in the heart of Napa Valley's renowned Rutherford growing region, specializing in sustainably farmed sauvignon blanc, cabernet sauvignon and other red Bordeaux varieties. Now celebrating its 40th anniversary, St. Supéry was founded by third-generation French vintner Robert Skalli in 1982 when he purchased the Dollarhide Ranch.

Located high in the northeastern mountains of Napa Valley, Dollarhide Ranch is 1,535 acres, with 500 acres of vineyards. This special property is the primary source of St. Supéry's distinctive estate-grown sauvignon blanc and cabernet sauvignon wines. The winery site in Rutherford is home to an additional 35 acres of vineyards, planted to cabernet sauvignon, merlot, cabernet franc and petit verdot.

St. Supéry's maintains Napa Green Winery and Vineyard certifications and enhances sustainability practices to protect the land and environment for generations to come.







Dollarhide Estate Vineyard

Dollarhide Ranch is a unique property in the northeastern hills of Napa Valley - a valley within a Napa Valley and the source for the majority of St. Supéry Estate wines. This special site is home to 500 acres of vineyards, along with rolling hills, flatlands, seven lakes and a vast array of wildlife.

Set at elevations ranging from 600 to 1,100 feet above sea level, the vineyard includes seven different soil series and 13 soil variations. This diversity of terroir and terrain creates ideal growing conditions for Bordeaux grape varieties and imparts distinctive character to our wines.

St. Supéry's regenerative farming practices work in harmony with the land to further enhance biodiversity and grow exceptional grapes.

Rutherford Estate Vineyard

Surrounding the winery along Napa's famed Highway 29, the Rutherford Estate Vineyard lies within the Rutherford Bench, a three-mile stretch of land prized for its mineral-rich alluvial soils and sandy clay loam. Cabernet sauvignon grown in this region is distinguished by its fine-grained tannins, known as "Rutherford Dust."

The vineyard's deep, well-drained soils allow the vines' root systems to mine for nutrients and water, yielding complex and concentrated flavors. St. Supéry cultivates 35 acres of red Bordeaux varieties here, including cabernet sauvignon, merlot, petit verdot and cabernet franc.









Napa Valley Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

This beautiful expression of Napa Valley cabernet sauvignon showcases fruit from both St. Supéry estate properties. The wine presents opulent purple and red hues, along with aromas of cassis, black plum and anise combined with subtle vanilla. Juicy blackberry and black currant flavors mingle with black licorice, espresso and toasted oak. Structured yet elegant, with velvety tannins.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

Cabernet sauvignon with merlot, malbec, cabernet franc and petit verdot

OAK MATURATION

100% French oak, about 1/3 new

Rutherford Estate Vineyard Merlot

This wine is a rich, graceful and elegant example of Rutherford terroir. To ensure a pure expression of perfectly ripe merlot, the fruit is hand-harvested in the cool morning hours and sorted by hand as well as with an optical sorter. Whole-berry fermentation in small barrels creates a seamless integration of French oak and a luscious mouthfeel. Flavors of rich black plum and chocolate, coupled with subtle raspberry and toasted vanillin barrel.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

Merlot with cabernet sauvignon and petit verdot

OAK MATURATION

100% French oak, about 60% new Partially barrel fermented









Dollarhide Estate Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon

This full-bodied, robust cabernet sauvignon comes from Dollarhide Estate Vineyard's oldest vines—now more than 30 years old. The wine has a rich, dense profile and subtle oak influence, with flavors of cassis and ripe black fruits. It also displays notes of espresso, mocha and molasses. A true reflection of mountainside Napa Valley terroir, this is a deep, structured wine with fine-grained tannins.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

98% cabernet sauvignon with 2% petit verdot

OAK MATURATION

100% French oak, about half new Partially barrel fermented

Dollarhide Estate Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc

Planted in 1985, "Parcel 5" is the oldest block of sauvignon blanc at Dollarhide Ranch and the primary source for this wine. Brightly colored with yellow and green hues, it presents notes of lemon, key lime and grapefruit, leading to aromas of kiwi, anise, wet gravel, and pear accented with a touch of tropical fruit. The flavors follow suit with crisp acidity balanced with a thread of toasty French oak and a textured mouthfeel.

OAK MATURATION

Stainless steel + 15%-20% new French oak Partially barrel fermented









Napa Valley Estate Élu

Élu, French for "chosen" or "elected," evolved from the desire of St. Supéry Winemaker Michael Scholz and renowned winemaking consultant Michel Rolland to craft an elegant red blend from each vintage that seamlessly reflects the best expression of hte season from St. Supéry's two estate vineyards. Flavors of dark fruit combine with elements of espresso and vanilla, as well as notes of smoky oak and dusty terroir. This red blend offers a finely textured silky structure with density and a graceful appeal. This is a wine of great density, yet with a sense of finesse and charm.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

Cabernet sauvignon dominant with merlot, malbec, cabernet franc and petit verdot

OAK MATURATION

100% French oak, about half new Partially barrel fermented

Napa Valley Estate Sauvignon Blanc

This bright, crisp Napa Valley sauvignon blanc is known for striking citrus notes and vintage after vintage consistency. The majority of the sauvignon blanc is from St. Supéry's own field selection of clone 1 that has been selected and propagated for over 20 years. A single-vineyard sauvignon blanc that showcases the broad, sun-kissed parcels spanning Dollarhide Ranch. Green and yellow hues present in this wine with exotic aromatics of pink grapefruit, green lime zest, lemon citrus with undertones of fennel and green olive. Flavors of lemon, lime, yellow grapefruit, and lime zest combine with a fennel and caper vibrancy.

Sustainability at St Supéry

St. Supéry Estate Vineyards and Winery is committed to sustainability in the vineyard, the winery and the community. Since 2008 and 2012, respectively, St. Supéry has maintained Napa Green Land and Napa Green Winery certifications to protect the land and environment for future generations. Cover crops planted between the vine rows harbor beneficial insects, add essential nutrients to the soil and limit erosion. A solar array offsets over 90% of St. Supéry's energy bill, and all winemaking, bottling and winery materials are recycled. St. Supéry focuses philanthropic efforts on education, underserved populations, the environment and healthcare accessibility.
